Bachelor's of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.) degree from a PCI-approved institution with at least 60% marks (55% for SC/ST)

Application Fee: (UR & OBC- Rs. 300), (SC/ST/PWD- Rs. 150)

Specialization available in **Pharmaceutics and Pharmacognosy**

NRI/Foreign students will be admitted as per University norms.

Selection procedure and norms for admission:

The following criteria will be maintained for the admission to M. Pharm programmes of University of North Bengal for the session 2023-24. Allotment of seats shall be based upon the category wise merit list prepared as per following norms-

Preparation of merit list:

On a scale of 100 calculated by considering -

Sl No.	Examination	Marks
1.	Higher Secondary (or equivalent)	20
2.	B. Pharm.	30
3.	Entrance Test	30
4.	Interview	20

N.B. The candidate should have a minimum of 50% attendance in the First fifteen days, failure of which, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.

However, the candidates who have appeared/are due to appear at the qualifying examinations (B. Pharm.) may also apply and such candidates, if selected, will be admitted if they can submit valid proof of their passing the qualifying examination with the required percentage of marks at the time of counseling. If the results are awaited on the date of counseling such selected candidates shall have to submit the mark sheet and provisional certificate of the qualifying examination within 30 days from the date of commencement of 1st-semester classes, failing of which or if the candidate is found non-eligible in terms of percentage of marks obtained, his/her admission will be cancelled.

The entrance test comprises 50 MCQs related to B. Pharm. syllabus as per PCI.

N.B.- Those who are awaiting the result of GPAT-2023, can also apply if qualified applicants can submit a valid GPAT score card at the time of the Entrance test (02.07.2023) in the form of hard copy.
